Wairarapa is located in the south east corner of the lower North Island. Just over an hour from Wellington, the Wairarapa is easily accessible by road, rail and air, and is at the heart of the Classic New Zealand Wine Trail. Essentially rural with off-the-beaten-track charm, Wairarapa offers a diverse experience for lovers of great wine, gourmet food, native wildlife and natural beauty. A designated Air Show train service will run out of Wellington on Saturday and Sunday of the show arriving prior to the air show and returning at the end of the day. There will be a designated Motor Home parking area adjacent to the air field available for air show ticket holders only. Disabled parking facilities will also be available.

INTRODUCTION

Trust House Wings Over Wairarapa 2011 will take place at Hood Aerodrome in Masterton on Friday 21 to Sunday 23 January 2011. Celebrating not only the aircraft but the men and women who have shaped the history of aviation, the 2011 show will be a tribute show that should not be missed. Widely regarded as one of Australasia's largest and fastest growing air shows Wings Over Wairarapa rivals any show for display, content and reputation

HOOD AERODROME

Wings Over Wairarapa shares its home at Hood Aerodrome with some of the finest privately owned collections of WWI and WWII aircraft in the world providing a backdrop for the show that is hard to rival.

AIRCRAFT

Over 70 aircraft will be displayed during the show providing a spectacular visual account of the history of aviation in New Zealand and around the world. PROGRAMME

FRIDAY 21 JANUARY – PRACTICE DAY

This will be the official practice day of the event with gates opening from 12.00pm with aircraft practising their displays throughout the afternoon culminating in an informal early evening show finishing at 7.00pm.

SATURDAY 22 – SUNDAY 23 JANUARY

Gates will open from 8.30am with the air display running from 11.00am to 4.30pm on both days. The programme may vary slightly on each day.
